- We open for groups of 30+ on the **first Thursday of each month** (please note we don't have the volunteer capacity to open on other days outside our regular Wednesdays and Sundays).
- Groups are welcome on Wednesdays and Sundays, except school holidays which can get very busy.
- Wednesday and Sunday mornings are also busier than afternoons, so you may like to consider visiting from 12pm onwards. Please arrive no later than 2.30pm and allow an hour to enjoy the visit.
